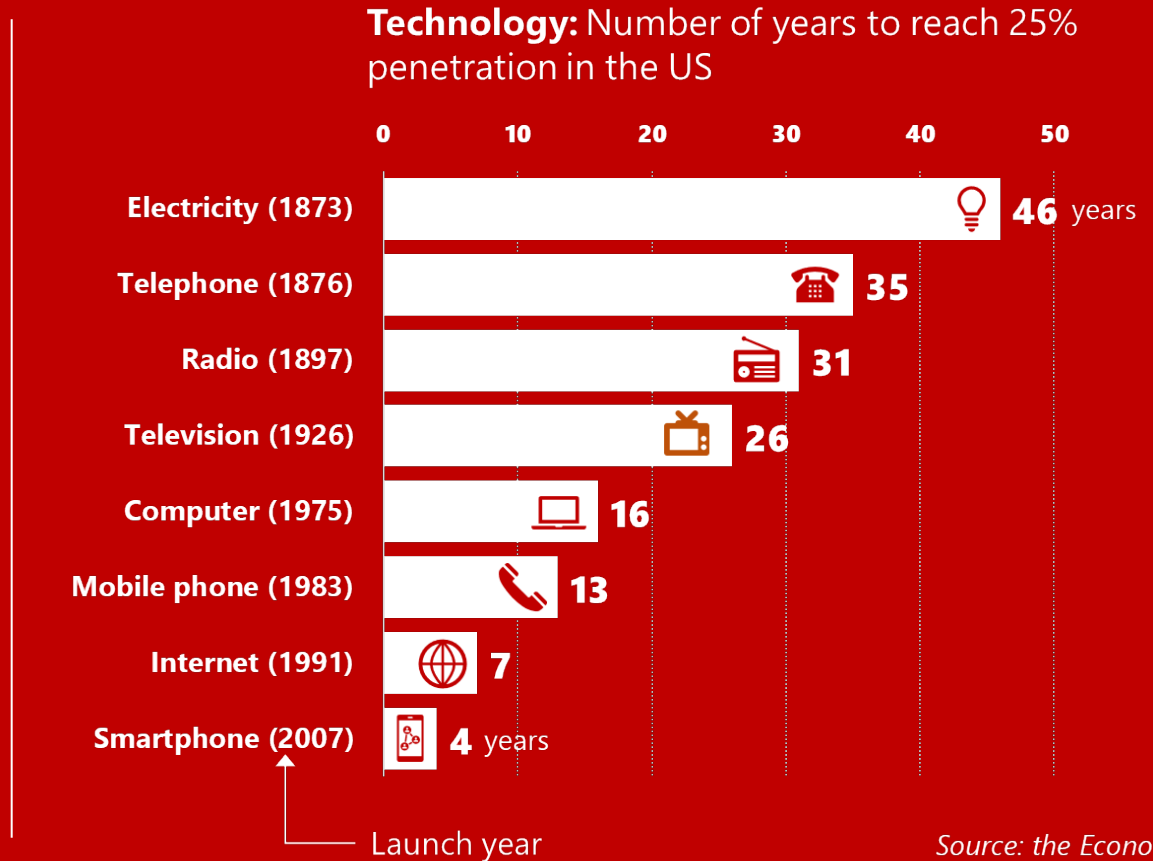

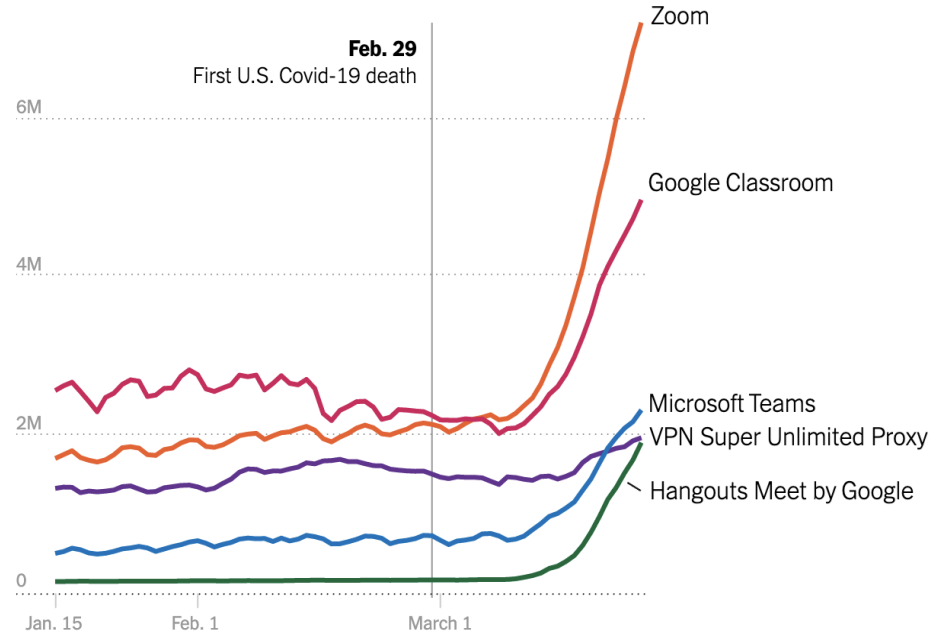

Daily app sessions for popular remote work apps

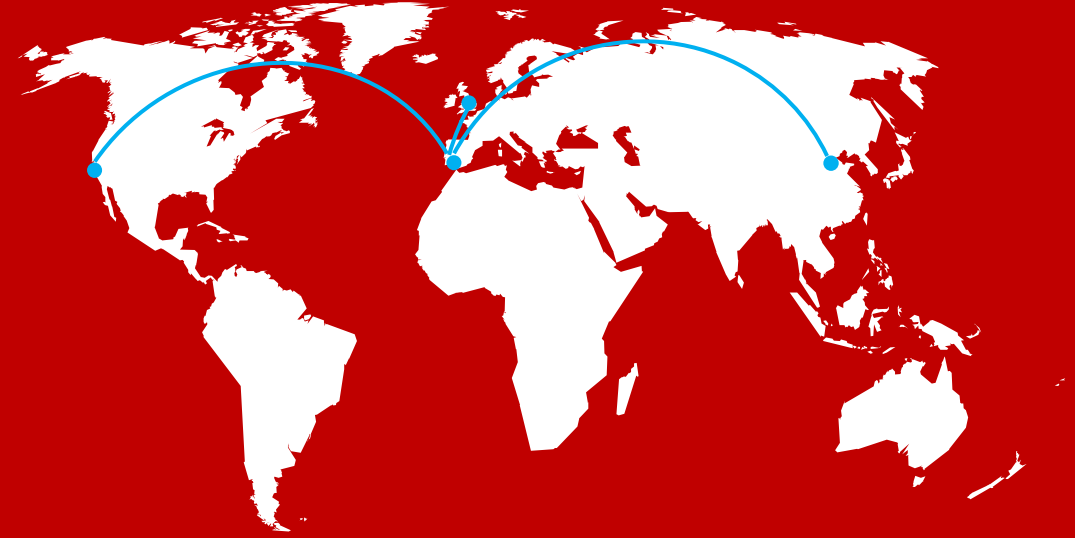


App popularity according to iOS App Store rankings on March 16-18. • Source: Apptopia

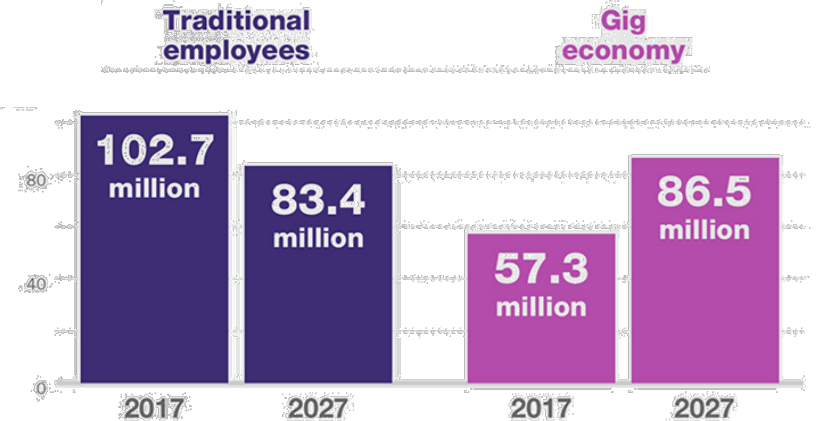

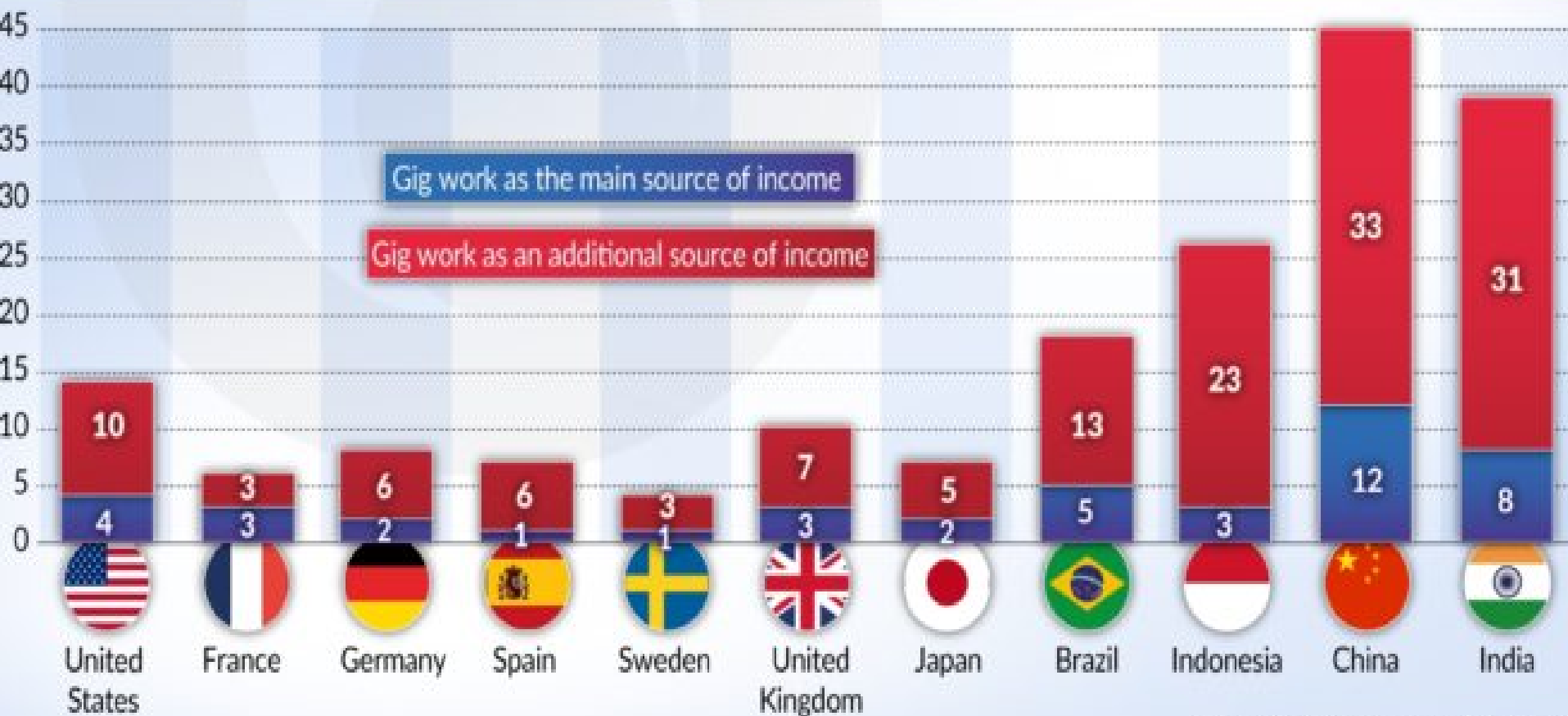
