

### **About Croatia**


- Size 56,594 km2
- Around 3 900 000 inhabitants
- Capital city: Zagreb
- Official language: Croatian
- Coastline 5.835 km
- 718 islands and islets
- 1 KUNA (abbrevation KN) = 100 LIPAS
- 1 EUR = 7,5 KUNA

## Taking up an employment



#### Accommodation

Employers are aware that seasonal workers need accommodation and most of them offer a room or a shared apartment which could be for free or with minimum cost. Larger companies usually have secured accommodation for their employees. Tourist entertainers and animators are accommodated in hotels and camps where they work.

#### Meals

 At least one meal, if not all three, is offered for free and additional meals won't cost much. Meals are provided in restaurants for personnel which is (most of the time) near working location.





### Work contract-in writen

- When you start
- Where and what will you do
- How long this employment would last
- Working hours, non-working days, annual leave
- Other important rights and obligations for you and employer

#### According to the labour law:

- 8 hours a day or 40 hours a week (during season working hours can be prolonged)
- Daily break 30 minutes



# **Earnings**



- Average monthly earning in 2021

  net 7.129 kuna (940 EUR) // 8900 kuna gross (1180 EUR)
- Minimum salary 4.687,50 kn (620 EUR)



















# **Ending employment**

- Temporary work contract with dates
- Written decision with the date and explanation





# **Costs of living in Croatia**

- Bread 9-18 kn (1,20 2,40 EUR)
- Meat 30-120 kn (1-16 EUR)
- Pizza 40-80 kn (5,50-10.50 EUR)
- Water (bottled, 1L) 6 kn (0,80 EUR)
- Juice 1L 10 kn (1,50 EUR)
- Beer (0,5) store 10 kn / bar 20 kn (1,50/2,7 EUR)
- Cinema (ticket) 40 kn (5,3 EUR)
- Gas 13 kn (1,70 EUR)
