 According to Croatian Bureau of Statistics, registered unemployment rate in the third quarter of 2022 was 6.7%

Shortages:

- Construction Industry (Bricklayers, Carpenters, Steel-benders, Heavy Construction Machine Operators, Floor Laying Workers, Plumbers, Electricians)
- Truck Drivers, Motor Vehicle Mechanics, Car Bodyworkers, Car Painters
- Chefs, Butchers, Bakers, Pastry Chefs
- Health personnel: medical technicians, dental assistants, health laboratory technicians and midwives
- Software Developers, Web and Multimedia Developers, System Administrators

Surpluses:

Photographers, Economists, Administrative secretaries, Clerks, Graphic Technicians, Ecology Technicians, Hotel and Tourism Clerks





Tourism sector in Croatia

- Tourism is undoubtedly the most important economic branch
- Tourist season, generally lasts from the beginning of April to the end of October
- Share of 6.5% of the total number of employees works in the tourism sector
- The share of tourism sector in GDP is almost 20%
- With around 20 million tourist arrivals in 2022 and a multi-year trend of increasing that number, Croatia is undoubtedly one of the most visited countries in the Mediterranean.

Entry and stay in Croatia



Nationals of an EEA member country and Switzerland

- For up to 3 months don't have to register
- More than 3 months must report as a temporary resident
- Permanent stay after 5 years of continuous legal residence

Third country nationals (non-EU)

- Required to have a stay and work permit
- An offer of employment from Croatian employer
- Easier procedure for seasonal workers in agriculture, forestry, hospitality and tourism sectors for a period of up to 90 days in the course of one calendar year







Labour conditions



- Prescribed minimum wage gross –700 EUR, net aproxx. 560,00 EUR a month
- Average net wage aproxx 1.050,00 EUR a month
- Social insurance contributions pension 20%, health 15%, accident 0,7 % (deducted from the salary)
- Income tax at rate of 20% and 30%



Labour conditions

- Types of contract (Indefinite period, Fixed-term work contracts-up to 3 years, Seasonal employment and Service contract)
- Written work contract (probation period also under contract)
- 40 hours max per week (daily work time max 12 hours, except seasonal activities max of 14 hours a day)
- Overtime: not more than 8 hours a week, 32 hours per month or 180 hours per year
- Paid annual leave of at least 4 weeks in a calendar year
- Probation period not longer than 6 months
- Workers right protection Unions, Labour inspection
