Main types of contracts

CDI: permanent contracts

- CDD: fixed-term contracts for a
- specific duration (max 18 months)
- Temping contract: same as CDD with 3 parties involved : employer, employee & temping agency

Other types of contracts

Intermittent :specific short term contract for artist or technician


Seasonal: in agriculture and tourism


