

FREE MOVEMENT OF WORKERS



- No restrictions for citizens of: EU member states, Norway, Lichtenstein, Iceland or Switzerland.
- Entry with a valid ID or passport.
- Within 3 days upon arrival register with the police.
- Within 3 months upon arrival residence registration certificate at the local Administrative Unit.

- Slovenians feel very safe in their environment.

 - Drivers (bus drivers, heavy truck drivers)




