Who can benefit?

JOBSEEKERS, JOB CHANGERS, EUROPEAN CITIZENS

- Jobseekers or job changers aged 18+
- Nationals of a EU country, Norway or Iceland, long-term residents in these countries
- Interested in moving to another EU country for a job, traineeship or apprenticeship
 - minimum 6 months for **job** offers
 - minimum 3 months for **traineeship** offers
- Regardless of their qualification level

EMPLOYERS

- legally established companies in the EU countries, Norway and Iceland compliant with national law
- offering a written **work contract** of at least:
 - 6 months for jobs or apprenticeships
 - 3 months for traineeships.
- Financial benefit only to SMEs (< 250 staff)

jobseekers, employers or jobs in the UK, Liechtenstein, Switzerland and third countries are not eligible

* **integration programme:** job-related training and/or language course, combined with other post-placement supports such as administrative support and settlement assistance (basic/comprehensive)





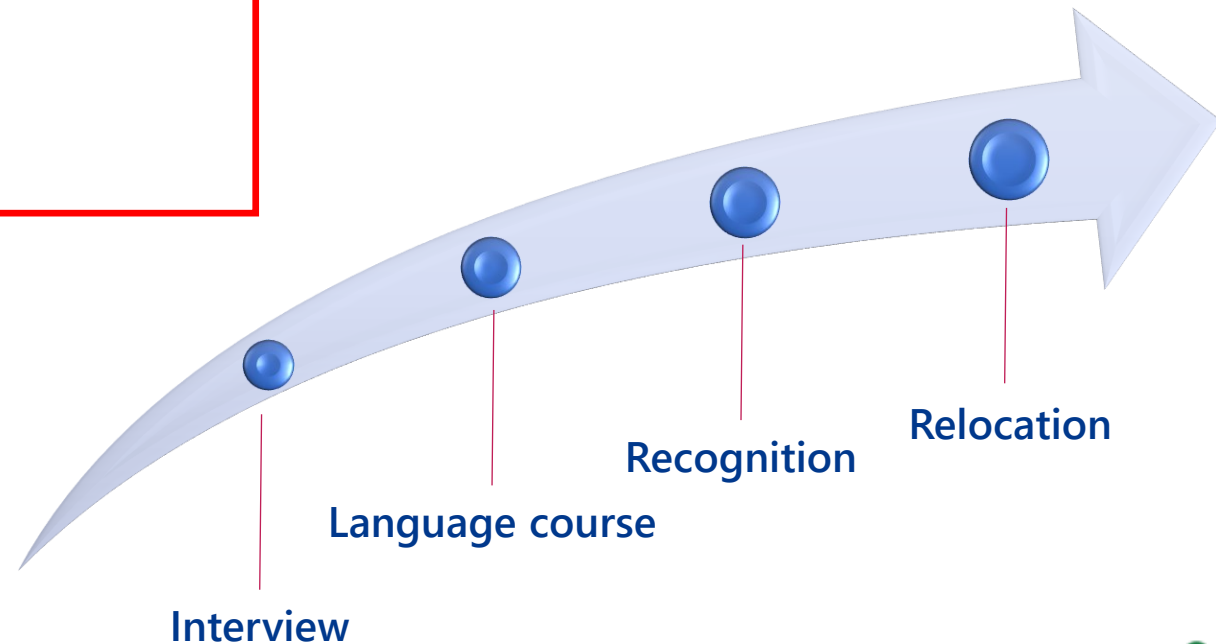
When to apply

Finding it hard to get a job or training opportunity in your country? Thinking of working abroad, but you do not know how to overcome the daunting obstacles?

Try the EURES Targeted Mobility Scheme.

What is Targeted Mobility Scheme?

- It offers dedicated support from national employment services for people seeking **work, training or apprenticeships** in another EU country, Norway or Iceland.
- On a fair basis, it tackles the needs of jobseekers to remove mobility obstacles.
- It helps **employers** in these countries who are looking for motivated and qualified workers.
- Available support includes **funding** to cover things like language courses, getting your qualifications recognised, travel and subsistence expenses.

Who can apply?

- Jobseekers aged **18 and over**.
- Nationals of an **EU country, Norway or Iceland** – or anyone legally resident in these countries.
- Any jobseeker, regardless of their **qualifications**.

Are you looking to recruit people with a specific profile, but struggling to find them in your own country? Want to build a multicultural team that can give your business the edge?

Try the EURES Targeted Mobility scheme.

What is Targeted Mobility Scheme?

- It offers your business **dedicated support** from local employment services to recruit motivated and qualified jobseekers from other European countries for work, traineeship or apprenticeship.
- If you are a **small or medium-sized business**, you can also apply for **financial support** to cover some of the training and integration costs for these new staff.

Who can apply?

- All businesses or organisations based in an EU country, Norway or Iceland, *regardless of economic sector or size*
- Any business offering a written **workcontract** of at least:
 - **6 months** for jobs or apprenticeships
 - **3 months** for traineeships.
- Any business/organisation offering a placement that is **compliant with national law**.

EURES Targeted Mobility Scheme (TMS) é um projeto financiado pela União Europeia (UE) destinado a ajudar cidadãos europeus a exercer o seu direito à liberdade de circulação em toda a UE. Tem como objetivo promover a mobilidade dentro da UE, fazendo corresponder candidatos a empregadores com vagas difíceis de preencher, incluindo serviços de mobilidade EURES e vários apoios financeiros.

O TMS tem como grupo-alvo candidatos a emprego com 18 ou mais anos e empregadores de um país da UE, da Noruega ou da Islândia e prevê apoios na vertente do emprego e um pequeno número de estágios.

O EURES Portugal é parceiro em 2 projetos TMS, juntamente com outros parceiros europeus: o liderado pelo EURES Suécia ([Arbetsformedlingen](#)) e o liderado pelo EURES Alemanha ([EURES Deutschland](#))

EURES Targeted Mobility Scheme (TMS) is an EU financed project designed to help European citizens to exercise their right to freedom of movement across the EU. TMS aims to increase mobility in EU by matching candidates with employers with hard to fill vacancies, including EURES mobility services and various financial supports.

Target groups are jobseekers aged 18 or older and employers from an EU country, Norway, or Iceland. TMS supports jobs and a small number of work-based traineeships.

EURES Portugal is a partner in 2 TMS projects, together with several other European partners: one is led by EURES Sweden ([Arbetsformedlingen](#)) and the other is led by EURES Germany ([EURES Deutschland](#))
