## Know before you come

Spain, despite the situation is improving, has a **high unemployment rate** for European standards:

- Spain unemployment rate Dec. 2023: 11,9 % (in some regions quite higher)
- EU unemployment Dec. 2023: 5,9%

And this is especially hard among young people: 27,9 %

But Spain is also a **fast-growing economy** in the EU.

National minimum wage 2024: 1134 €/month, 37,8 €/working day But most salaries are indexed to Collective Agreements

More sectors in the need for personnel



#### The Spanish Labour Market: sectors on the rise

Sectors in which EURES Spain has detected the need to hire European jobseekers every year:

- Language teachers
- Tourism and Hospitality sector, Summer entertainers
- **Call centres** and **customer service** (native speakers of foreign languages. Profiles: customer services, marketing, human resources, accounting)
- **IT sector:** electronic engineering, software and applications development, multimedia engineering and telecommunications engineering
- International trade
- Healthcare professionals

#### The tourist sector is Key



- According to the latest World Tourism Barometer of the UNWTO, Spain is the second tourist destination in the world, with around 85 million international arrivals in 2023
- Main Season: Easter October, but in the big cities (Madrid, Barcelona) and in the Canary Islands the season is the whole year.
- 8,6 million cruise passengers arriving to our ports every year
- 2,67 million employed workers in Tourist-Hospitality sector in Spain
- HORECA & Tourism means 13,1% of the Spanish GDP, 1,5 points more than 2022



#### Working conditions,

- Working time: Tourist sector demands flexibility. The working week is **40 hours** a week, and shifts are the normal way of organization
- Probably, a lot of extra hours. Check whether they are paid
- Other benefits: Accommodation and meals, travel costs (or part), training...
- Unemployment Benefit: you need 12 months of contributions to get an unemployment benefit in Spain
- Holidays: 22 working days x year 30 calendar days (2,5 x month) but check your collective agreement, it can be more
