Who can benefit?



JOBSEEKERS

- Jobseekers aged 18+
- Nationals of a EU country, Norway or Iceland
- Third country nationals who are long term residents (Directive 2003/109 EC)
- Interested in moving to another EU country for a job, traineeship or apprenticeship
 - minimum 6 months for **job** or **apprenticeship** offers
 - minimum 3 months for **traineeship** offers
- Regardless of their qualification level



EMPLOYERS

- Legally established companies in the EU countries, Norway and Iceland compliant with national law
- Offering a written **work contract** (compliant with the respective country labour law) of at least:
 - 6 months for jobs or apprenticeships
 - 3 months for traineeships.

Jobseekers and employers in the UK, Liechtenstein, Switzerland **are not eligible**

Direct Financial support related to transnational placements

JOBSEEKERS

On-going projects led by Germany, Sweden

Job Interview	The amount provided may vary according to the distance (from 110 to 385 +55 eur per diem)
Relocation allowance	The amount varies according to the country of destination from min. 770 Eur to max 1540
Family Relocation	Flat rate per family according to the country of destination from 550 to 1540
Language training	Reimbursement of actual declared costs up to 2.200€
Recognition of diplomas	Flat rate up to 440 Eur
Supplementary trip	Flat rate up to 550 Eur
Subsistence allowance	Flat rate up to 660 Eur/month for max 6 months

New projects led by Italy, Germany, Sweden 2025-27

Job interview	<u>Unit costs</u> for travel costs
Language training	Reimbursement of actual declared costs up to 2.200€
Mobility allowance including family allowance	Mobility allowance: 600 Eur x 3 Family allowance: 660x2
Recognition of diplomas	Flat rate up to 440 Eur

Financial support to deliver **integration** (*basic or comprehensive*) programmes to recruited candidates



Flat rate costs ranging from min 810 to max 2.000 EUR



**Only for SMEs
(up to 250 workers)**



Financial support to deliver **training programmes** to candidates



Actual costs in –company and external training up to 1500 EUR

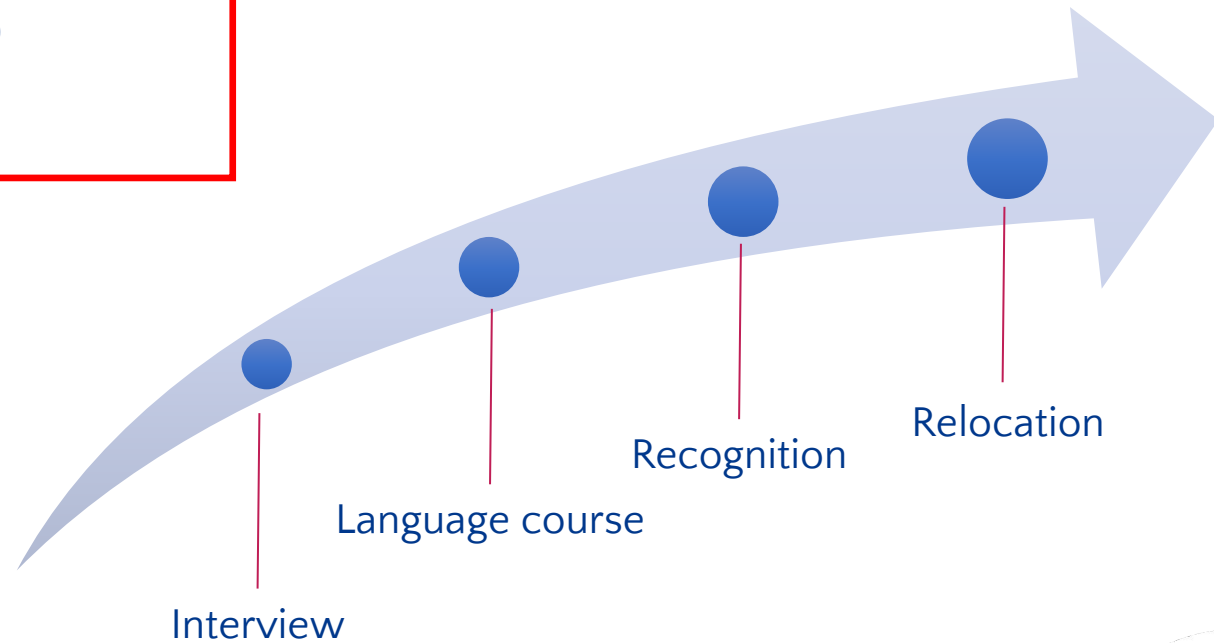


When to apply?

Jobseekers



Finding it hard to get a job or training opportunity in your country? Thinking of working abroad, but you do not know how to overcome the daunting obstacles?

Try the EURES Targeted Mobility Scheme.

What is Targeted Mobility Scheme?

- It offers dedicated support from national employment services for people seeking work, training or apprenticeships in another EU country, Norway or Iceland.
- On a fair basis, it tackles the needs of jobseekers to remove mobility obstacles.
- It helps employers in these countries who are looking for motivated and qualified workers.
- Available support includes funding to cover things like language courses, getting your qualifications recognised, travel and subsistence expenses.

Who can apply?

- Jobseekers aged 18 and over.
- Nationals of an EU country, Norway or Iceland – or anyone legally resident in these countries.
- Any jobseeker, regardless of their qualifications.

Try the EURES Targeted Mobility scheme.

What is Targeted Mobility Scheme?

- It offers your business dedicated support from local employment services to recruit motivated and qualified jobseekers from other European countries for work, traineeship or apprenticeship.
- If you are a small or medium-sized business, you can also apply for financial support to cover some of the training and integration costs for these new staff.

Who can apply?

- All businesses or organisations based in an EU country, Norway or Iceland, regardless of economic sector or size
- Any business offering a written workcontract of at least:
 - 6 months for jobs or apprenticeships
 - 3 months for traineeships.
- Any business/organisation offering a placement that is compliant with national law.

Where can your business recruit?

In any EU country, Iceland or Norway
