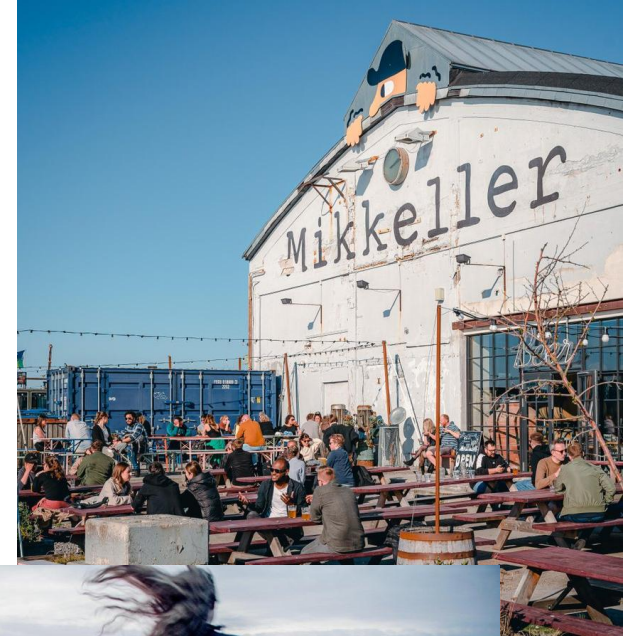

# How to Apply (Danish Job Culture)

- No standard CV → tailor it
- 1–2 pages maximum
- Short, personal cover letter
- Mention availability clearly
- Follow up politely if relevant
