REQUISITES

TO PRACTICE NURSING IN THE

GERMAN-SPEAKING

SWITZERLAND:

. nursing degree obtained from an EU University or equivalent;

. European or non-EU nationality ;

. newly-graduated or with experience after graduation;

. certification of proficiency - at least at a B2 level - in the German Language (Goethe ou TELC).



SALARY PACKAGE MAIN ASPECTS

- . Full-time permanent work contract (job stability).
- . The salary will vary according to one's experience and/or German level.
- . **Gross annual salary of at least CHF 70.000** (Swiss Francs), depending on one's German level and professional experience (nurses with over 5 years of experience, good German level and/or specialists usually command salaries of around CHF 85.000, with some even reaching CHF 100.000 per annum).
- . **Monthly net salary** (paid 13 times in one year) - after taxes - **of at least CHF 5100** (considering the most conservative estimate of a gross salary of CHF 70.000 per annum).
- . Paid holidays (an average of 27 days per annum).
- . Continued support, namely on assisting with finding accommodation.

S T E P S

1 Initial meeting (in person or via Skype/Zoom) with Amplia's consultants. Presenting the job offer, underlining the its main aspects and planning the next steps.

2 German language course: while not free, we have established partnerships with language schools in Portugal that will allow you to take the course up to a B2 level with the maximum quality and ease of pay.

3 If you're already speaking German at a B1 level, we'll submit your application to our Swiss partners. We'll make arrangements for the process and we'll advise you regarding possible destinations, among hospitals, clinics or nursing homes.

4 Interview with the hospital and job offer. After having obtained your B2 German level certification, you'll finally start working. After approximately 2 months, you'll obtain your nursing degree equivalency and will perform in your role as a nurse. You'll have our team at your disposal in all matters pertaining to the relocation process, from finding accommodation to other important issues (integration plan).

DEGREE EQUIVALENCY

STEP 1: attaining a B2 level in the German language (Goethe or TELC exam). Without knowledge of the local language and the certification to attest it, you'll not be given equivalency by the Swiss Red Cross (local regulating authority).

STEP 2: register ("precheck") in the platform - www.precheck.ch/account/login -, where you must insert your personal data and attach the following documents:

- . ID card (your country's civilian ID document);
- . a copy of your diploma;

The Swiss Red Cross will make a preliminary analysis for free (usually within 15 days) and will then reply to you, giving you a list of additional documents to attach and instructions on how to proceed.

STEP 3: payment and registration. After confirming, at the end of the "precheck" process, that the documents are correct, the Red Cross will instruct you on how to proceed to the payment of your registration in the council, a total sum of CHF 730. Only after this will your NAREG registration - the Swiss national registry of healthcare professionals - be confirmed. Additionally, you should attach to the process:

- . your B2 German language certification;
- . certification of "Good Standing" (you can request it at your local council - it will be valid for 3 months).

NOTD: all the documents must be translated and authenticated by a translator with the official Swiss registry of translators (we can provide assistance with this). The documentation should be translated to French, German or Italian. The documents must be the originals.

APART FROM THE DOCUMENTS FOR DIPLOMA EQUIVALENCY AT THE SWISS RED CROSS, YOU SHOULD PRODUCE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS FOR YOUR APPLICATION

- . your CV in German;
- . character references (translated to German) from former employers of college professors;
- . motivation letter (explaining why you wish to work in Switzerland; outlining your personal features and professional skills that might bring something to your prospective employer).
