- **cook**: € 20,0591 gross/hour
- waiter in restaurant, brasserie, taverne or bistro: € 15,9535 gross/hour
- waiter in a cafe: € 15,0889 gross/hour
- waiter in a pension: € 14,4539 gross/hour
- **kitchen chef**: € 21,3327 gross/hour

What to do after the end of the contract?

- possibility to get another job, lots of job offers in Hospitality
- many job opportunities in Flanders:
 contact VDAB Flemish Public Employment Service: international@vdab.be
- ask for U1-form at the RVA, proof of your employment in Belgium to take home with you ask for unemployment benefit in your home country if unemployed
- de-register at the municipality
