### **Cost of living and earnings**

#### **Cost of living**

- Higher compared to other European countries
- Large cities vs mid-sized cities
- Amsterdam, Rotterdam vs Eindhoven, Maastricht

#### **Earnings**

- Higher compared to other European countries
- Netherlands ranked 4<sup>th</sup> average annual wages in Europe, after Iceland, Luxemburg and Switzerland (statista.com)

Costs of living are higher, however earnings are also higher.
