Facts and Figures about Malta


- ► Geographic size: just 316 km²
- Population size: over 500,000
- Official languages: Maltese and English
- Currency: the Euro, since 1 January 2008
- Malta joined the EU on the 1st of May 2004
- Climate: Average temperatures: 23°C (daytime)
- Capital city: Valletta
- Annual tourist arrivals: over 3 million (in 2023)
- Religion: Roman Catholic (over 90% of the population)



Tourism Sector in Malta

- Tourism in Malta is an important sector of the country's economy, contributing to about 15% of the nation's gross domestic product (GDP)
- Malta's strategic position in the Mediterranean Sea, its rich history, and its architectural tradition have long made the island an attractive tourist destination
- There are a number of aquatic activities to enjoy in Malta as well as Gozo and Comino. Malta is home to the country's beach resorts and holiday areas

Working conditions

- **Employment Contracts**: Indefinite or Definite contracts
- Working Hours: 40 hours plus 8 hours overtime per week for full time employees
- Vacation leave entitlement: 216 h of paid annual leave for full time employees
- Notice Period: Notice is calculated on the employee's continuous length of service.
 E.g. more than 1 month and up to 6 months 1 week notice
- Minimum wage:

Age 18 years and over	€213.54
Age 17 years	€206.76
Under 17 years	€203.92


• Wage Regulation Orders: aim to regulate wages and other conditions of employment in specific industries

Living in Malta

- Most rental accommodation is privately owned and properties for rent can be located on Real Estate agents' websites. These can be found on Google. €700+ per month, depending on size/area
- It is important that you have a valid European Health Insurance Card
- Buses are the cheapest and most useful of Malta's public transportation systems. Most routes operate between 5:00 and 23:00
- If you intend to stay in Malta for more than 3 months you should apply for your residence card with Identity Malta. Contact us about this
- Living in Malta is affordable when compared to other European countries





Finding a Job in Malta

To **look for work** in Malta it is recommended that you register on the Jobsplus website (<u>www.jobsplus.gov.mt</u>) to apply for jobs advertised directly through the website

To **apply for a job** in Malta, it is of utmost importance to have an updated CV and cover letter in English

- ► You can use the <u>Europass website</u> format to update your CV
- When you apply for a job, you should submit a CV in English that contains the following information:
 - personal details
 - educational background
 - previous employment
 - skills (including language skills, technical skills, digital skills, etc.)
