Trade unions

- Employer's organisations and trade unions negotiate salaries and employment terms
 - Minimum wages not regulated by law
- Trade union representatives on most work places (da. tillidsrepræsentant)
 - Consider a membership

Unemployment Insurance

• You are NOT automatically insured against unemployment (voluntary)

Jnemployment insurance fund = "A-kasse"

• Most unemployment insurance funds are affiliated with specific trade unions

Work Contract

- Employment agreement with information about:
- Your employer
- Weekly working hours
- Salary
- Starting date
- Job description/job title
- Rights concerning holidays and days off
- Pension contributions
- Lodging, meals and sick pay

Remember to save a copy of your contract!

- CV
- Cover letter
- Only attach other documents if specifically requested in the job ad

- Targeted and easy to read and understand
- 2 A4 pages
- Focus on company needs
- Select information carefully to target your CV
- Consider format

- Personal Details
- Personal profile
- Work Experience
- Education
- Skills
- Interests
- References

Cover letter

- Max 1 A4 page
- Future oriented
- Focus on what the company will gain form hiring you not what you will gain or expect to learn
- Pick 3-5 essential requirements and answer them carefully
- Include why you wish to work for this particular company
