Before coming *Checklist*



EUROPEAN
JOB DAYS

- Valid **ID card** or **Passport**
- Traveling with **family**? Check procedures & documents for children/spouse
- Copy of work contract / working conditions **in written**
- Knowing the **wage payment method** and frequency
- Enough money to remain in Portugal until 1st wage payment (or to go back...)
- Check **accommodation availability and price**
- **Certificates** proving experience, education/training, references
- European Health Insurance Card / Health Insurance

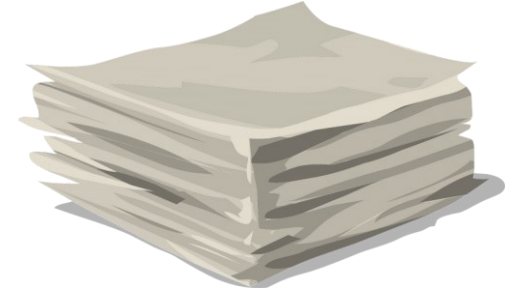
- Check employers' location and available transports (airports; bus; railways; metro...)
- Driving? Valid driving license? Check traffic rules, parking costs and be aware of Electronic Tolls, prepare Maps, etc.
- Check weather conditions, emergency warnings...
- Find out about cultural & social life
- Inform you family and friends about your destination, arrival schedule & contacts

1. **Registration Certificate** or Residence Card (>3 months)
2. **Fiscal Number (NIF):** www.portaldasfinancas.gov.pt
3. **Social security number (NISS):** www.seg-social.pt The employer usually helps you
4. **Bank account**
5. **Register at nearest Health Centre: SNS (National Health Care System) User's Card**
