Entry and stay in Croatia

Nationals of an EEA member country and Switzerland

- For up to 3 months don't have to register
- More than 3 months must report as a temporary resident
- Permanent stay after 5 years of continuous legal residence

Third country nationals (non-EU)

- Required to have a stay and work permit
- An offer of employment from a Croatian employer
- Easier procedure for seasonal workers in agriculture, forestry, hospitality and tourism sectors for a period of up to 90 days in the course of one calendar year

- Milk (1 I) 0.82-1.5 €
- Eggs (12 pcs) 1.91-3.6 €
- Apples (1 kg) 0.93-2 €
- Water (1.5 | bottle) 0.66-1.5 €
- Beer (0,5 l) store 1-2 € / bar 2-4 €)
- Cinema (ticket) 5-9 €
- Fuel (1 l) 1.4-1.86 €









Labour market trends

According to the Croatian Bureau of Statistics, registered unemployment rate in the 3rd quarter of 2023 was **5.5**%

Shortages

- Bricklayer, carpenter, concrete placer, concrete finisher, welder, plasterer, house builders, earth moving and related plant operator, stonemason, crane operator, cabinet-maker, building construction labourer, civil engineering labourer, pipe fitter, painter, roofer, plumber, building repairs electrician, insulation worker, fitter of metal structures, tile setter, floor layer, locksmith, electrical mechanic, electrician,...
- Heavy truck and lorry driver, motor vehicle mechanics, spray painters, sheet metal workers
- Chef, butcher, baker, pastry chef
- Computer programmer, UI designer, system administrator

Tourism and hospitality in Croatia

- Tourism is undoubtedly the most important economic branch
- Tourist season generally lasts from the beginning of April to the end of October
- The number of employees in the sector is between 6.5 and 13.3%
- The share of tourism and hospitality sector in the GDP is between 11 and 18% (EU leader)
- With around 20.6 million tourist arrivals in 2023 and a multi-year trend of increasing that number, Croatia is one of the most visited countries in the Mediterranean







- Prescribed minimum wage gross 840 EUR, net approx. 677 EUR per month
- Average net wage approx. 1 208 EUR per month
- Average net wage in the tourism and hospitaly sector varies from ca. 800 EUR per month (cleaner) to ca. 1300 EUR per month (chef)
- Social insurance contributions pension 20%, health 16.5% (deducted from the salary)
- Income tax rates are between 20% and 30%







- Types of contract (Indefinite period, fixed-term work contracts up to 3 years, seasonal employment and service contract)
- Written work contract (probation period also under contract)
- 40 working hours max per week (daily work time max 12 hours, except seasonal activities - max of 14 hours a day)
- Overtime: not more than 8 hours a week, 32 hours per month or 180 hours per year
- Paid annual leave of at least 4 weeks in a calendar year
- Probation period for no longer than 6 months
- Workers' rights protection Unions, Labour Inspection
