House rents can greatly vary depending on the city and the area. Rents tend to be higher in major cities and in touristic regions.







EU citizens covered by the TEAM card (European Health Insurance Card) are entitled to emergency medical treatment. To be entitled to healthcare it is necessary to register (free of charge) with the Italian National Health Service, and select a GP, or pediatrician, from a list of doctors available at the local Health Authority office (Asl).
