HOW TO FIND A JOB in Italy

1 PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

Job Centers (Centri per l'impiego – CPI) are public structures located throughout the country and coordinated by the Regions or Autonomous Provinces.

They provide guidance and advisory services and facilitate the matching of labour supply and demand.

The **EURES** service is available at each CPI, providing information on vacancies in the European Economic Area and guidance and advice on living and working conditions in the various European countries.



EURES organises regular job fairs in many countries and online.

5 DIRECT CONTACT WITH A COMPANY

If you are interested in working at a specific company, it may be a good idea to apply for a job with them directly. Many companies include information on available positions on their websites. If you don't find career information on a company's website, you can contact them directly to ask if they can accept an open application or you can send a speculative application to let them know about your skills.

6 NETWORKING

Last but not least, NETWORKING is a great way to find work in Italy because most vacancies are filled informally.

Personal networks and existing contacts from work or school also provide a considerable number of opportunities, so try to cultivate personal contacts in sectors you are interested in.
