In order to sign any kind of employment contract, rent a house, open a bank account, you need a codice fiscale (tax code).

The codice fiscale (tax code) is an alphanumeric code for residents on Italian territory.

Normally this code is assigned when you arrive in Italy and you ask for it at the Agenzia delle Entrate.

With the same document, on the back, you get the health card that Italian citizens need for all health services.

For citizens coming from an EU country, it guarantees urgent health services.

The registration with the National Health Service, which entitles you to have the health card, is free of charge.

It's a personal document that contains information of a fiscal and health nature and allows access to various public services.

It consists of 16 alphanumeric characters and is issued by the Italian Revenue Agency.

The Health card is a personal document issued to individuals entitled to benefit of the Italian National Health Service.

The card contains several information, such as the biographical data and the tax identification number. It shall be valid for 6 years or until the expiration of the residence permit.

In case of loss, it is possible request a duplicate of the health card from:

- ➤T he territorial offices of the National Health Service Asl
- > the Italian Revenue Agency, through online services
- \succ the form.





To be entitled to healthcare it is necessary to register (free of charge) with the Italian National Health Service, and select a GP, or pediatrician, from a list of doctors available at the local Health Authority office (Asl).

A Taxpayer Identification Number "**Codice Fiscale**" in order to deal with Public Bodies and Administrations





Non-Italian citizens need:

Foreigners require a valid passport or residence permit.

Infants require only a birth certificate or parent self-certification.

ATTENTION:

The only acceptable Fiscal Code is the one issued by the Revenue office.

No one else is authorised to produce software programmes for the computation of Fiscal Codes or to print cards.





How to apply for a tax identification number abroad

Non-resident individuals who need to obtain the tax identification number can apply for it to the Italian consular authorities in the Country of residence.

You have to contact your local Revenue office and exhibit an identity document to obtain this code.





How to apply for a tax identification number in Italy

Non EU citizens can obtain the tax identification number either at the Single desk for immigration "Sportelli Unici per l'immigrazione" or by any Police headquarters "Questure".

The Single desk for immigration issues the tax identification number to citizens who apply for entry into the Country either for employment purposes or for reunite with their family. Police headquarters assign the tax identification number to foreign nationals who require either the issuance or the renewal of a residence permit.

In any other situation, the tax identification number can be obtained from the offices of the Italian Revenue Agency, by submitting a request indicating the personal data and the residence for tax purposes where the card should be delivered.





Citizens from non-EU Countries must submit at least one of the following documents:

□ a valid passport with visa (if required), or any other document accepted by the Italian authorities a certificate of identity issued by the Italian diplomatic or consular authorities of the Country of nationality (with photo)

□ a valid residence permit (permesso di soggiorno)

□ an ID card issued by the municipality of residence in Italy.

Non-EU citizens must also prove that they have the right to stay, even temporarily, in Italy.





What to do in case of incorrect data on the tax identification number card

In case of incorrect data showed on the tax identification number card, a replacement must be required to any office of the Italian Revenue Agency, showing a valid identification document.

What to do in case of loss or theft

You can request a duplicate of the tax identification number by filling the request online. As an alternative, you can request it directly to a territorial office of the Italian Revenue Agency.
