

# Hygiene concept 2021 - Bavaria Instruction sheet for exhibitors

### Primary protection goals are:

- 1. enabling the respective current distance rules to be applied
- 2. traceability of contacts
- 3. feasibility of the german 3G concept (vaccinated, tested, recovered)

What applies to **EXHIBITORS**? (as of beginning of september 2021):

### Set-up and dismantling

- The current SARS-CoV-2 occupational health and safety regulations of the federal government apply on the stand area.
- Outside the stand area, the hygiene concept for trade fairs applies (obligation to wear a medical mask)

#### **During the fair**

- The current federal occupational health and safety regulations apply to you and your employees.

- Instruction of staff in hand hygiene and individual hygiene standards
- For catering stands, the current hygiene concept for the catering industry in Bavaria applies.

## Admission regulations:

- A check on the basis of the 3G admission concept (vaccinated, tested, recovered) is not necessary for exhibitors, but recommended.
- Keeping daily staff lists on the stand
- Personalised permanent passes for exhibitors

#### Obligation to wear a mask:

- Wearing of a medical mask indoors (minimum requirement)
- In outdoor areas / open-air grounds: obligation to wear a medical mask if the minimum distance cannot be maintained.
- In cashier and counter areas, the obligation to wear a medical mask does not apply if employees are reliably protected by transparent partitions (see occupational health and safety).
  - → Transparent partitions can be ordered via the Online Service Centre / homepage.



Outlook for our and your **VISITORS** (as of beginning of september 2021):

- Admission to the fair for visitors only if one of the 3Gs is proven.
  - → Visitors are comprehensively informed in advance, test stations are available in the immediate vicinity
- Indoor areas: obligation to wear a medical mask
- Open-air grounds: obligation to wear a medical mask if the minimum distance cannot be maintained
