Belgian labour market situation



- Shortage of qualified workers
- Surplus of unqualified workers
- **High Interregional Mobility**
- Lack of bilingualism French/Dutch or even multilingualism
- is required (Dutch, French/English/German)

Shortages in Belgium



- IT (software developer, project manager,...)
- **Engineering (civil engineer, engineer in industry,...)**
- Healthcare (nurse, geriatric helpers, hospital doctors...)
- **Construction (welder, roofer, electrician, bricklayer,...)**

Technicians (production technician in biopharmacy, maintenance technician and automotive diagnostic, refrigeration technician,...)




