ACCOMODATION

The choice depends on the length of stay.

- Rooms (including the use of the kitchen) can vary from 300-600 € per month.

Rooms for rent can be found on newspapers and/or specialized magazines, and on Internet.

- Apartments can be found through private individuals and/or real estate agencies (websites).

House rents can greatly vary depending on the city and the area. Rents tend to be higher in major cities and in touristic regions.





Services National Card (CNS)



It's a personal document that contains information of a fiscal and health nature and allows access to various public services. It consists of 16 alphanumeric characters and is issued by the Italian Revenue Agency.

EU citizens covered by the TEAM card (European Health Insurance Card) are entitled to emergency medical treatment.

To be entitled to healthcare it is necessary to register (free of charge) with the Italian National Health Service, and select a GP, or pediatrician, from a list of doctors available at the local Health Authority office (Asl).



Italy's economy is ranked as fourth largest in the Eurozone and the eighth-largest in the world


The country is known for its large and competitive agricultural sector (the world's largest wine producer) and for its influential and high quality automobile, tourism, machinery, food, design and fashion industry

The occupations pillar is one of the three pillars of ESCO. It organises the occupation concepts in ESCO. It uses hierarchical relationships between them, metadata as well as mappings to the International Standard Classification of Occupations (ISCO) in order to structure the occupations.

Each occupation concept contains one preferred term and any number of non-preferred terms and hidden terms in each of the ESCO languages.
