- Valid ID card or Passport
- Traveling with family? Check procedures & documents for children/spouse
- Copy of work contract / working conditions in written
- Certificates proving experience, education/training, references
- Knowing the wage payment method and frequency
- Check accommodation availability and price
- European Health Insurance Card / Health Insurance
- Enough money to remain in Portugal until 1st wage payment (or to go back...)

- Register at nearest Health Centre: SNS (National Health Care System) User's Card


